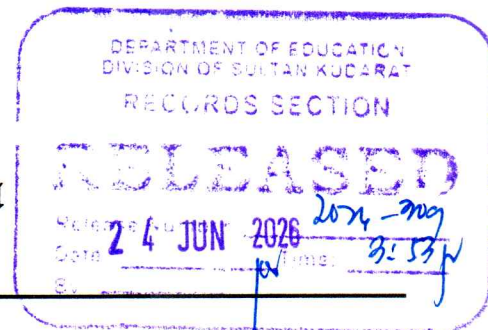

**IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP)
FOR SY 2026-2027**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chiefs of the Functional Divisions

This Division

1. The Department of Education – Division of Sultan Kudarat, through the School Health Section, is committed to continue the steadfast implementation of School-Based Feeding Program for School Year 2026-2027 through the provision of nutritious food products, hot meals and milk products among identified learners to increase school attendance, performance, and to improve their nutritional status.
2. In line with this, school implementers are hereby directed to facilitate the implementation of the program by ensuring the provision of nutritious food products along with hot meals for 120 feeding days or more under the regular component and 30 feeding days or more under the Milk Feeding Component. Moreover, the preparation and finalization of SBFP forms, including the Pakyaw Agreement for hired workers with all necessary attachments and other required documents, must be accomplished accordingly.
3. The delivery of food commodities to the selected school drop-off points will commence upon the completion of the Division Office's procurement processes. Assigned drop-off point personnel, including Nurses/Feeding Coordinators, Central School/School Bookkeepers, TLE Coordinators, and District/School Asset Managers (formerly known as District Property Custodians), shall oversee the completeness and quality of the delivered food commodities. The delivery and distribution of food items to beneficiaries within the schools shall be carried out by hired workers and parent volunteers. Furthermore, the SBFP Core Group is expected to perform its respective roles and responsibilities to ensure the successful implementation of the program.

All school implementers are enjoined to conduct pre-implementation activities, such as school-based orientations for parents and other stakeholders, to gain their cooperation and ensure the smooth and successful implementation of the program. A simple kick-off activity may also be conducted during the first week of the feeding implementation. The School Health Section personnel, together with the assigned district nurses, shall spearhead, monitor, and provide technical assistance to schools and designated school drop-off points to ensure efficient program management.
5. The SDO-led Central Kitchen Core Group members are expected to carry out their roles and responsibilities in accordance with the developed and duly signed Structural and Operational Plan to ensure the effective delivery of services.
7. Secondary schools are encouraged to facilitate nutrition-related activities to address under and/or over nourishment of learners and to foster healthy eating habits in school and at home.
